She is also serving as Secretary/Treasurer for VILMTA and will be co-chairing the e-Festival this Spring with other board members. The Achievement in Music program in ISMTA has always kept her busy for Gateway Arch East MTA. Deb Meier and LeAnn co-chaired AIM for 18 years for the exams held at SWIC. Now, she's scheduling the Theory Exams in February and printing the exams for both Theory and Performance for the students taking exams at SWIC. Along with teaching, she has enjoyed creating music products which truly helps students understand music better for Music Perceptions. There are currently over 60 products in the Music Perceptions online store, and LeAnn has been branching out into other areas, too. Sheet Music Plus and Sheet Music Direct have digital download books and sheet music that she has written. SuperScore Music has books and sheet music that she has written for the iPad app SuperScore. 


## News from Members



Several of **Gill Cerbin**'s students won Gold awards at the Arch Cup competition at Webster University in October.



Joan Witte performed three selections on the lever harp: *For the Beauty of the Earth* arr. By Daniel Burton, *Aquatinte No. I* by Bernard Andrés, and *Amazing Grace* arr. by Richard Kingsmore. She also shared some information on how the harp works and how the pedal and lever harps differ.


